Message from the Principal

By golly, I think we have done it!

"What have we done?" I hear you question in excited anticipation. Well I am glad you asked. I think we have managed to set up for a successful Zoom delivery of our end of year assembly. I know, I know, it's exciting. We had a trial run this week and even though there may be a few slight issues with sound, I am quietly confident (forgoing any unforeseen disasters or technical issues) that we will be able to link everyone in for the end of year assembly in week 11. Next week we will send home the link and the code for the Zoom meeting, but what we need you to do in the meantime is find the information that was sent home during Learning from Home with your child's log on information. You will need to be logged on your child to be able to access the meeting.

It is important to note that due to all staff being involved in the assembly, we will not be able provide technical assistance if something goes wrong on your end, so I highly recommend logging on early so that you have time to troubleshoot. I anticipate starting the assembly at 10:30am, however will open the meeting from 10:00am to allow you time to get your ducks in a row. I will also send home a reminder about Zoom etiquette as it is easy to forget. Everyone who logs in will be projected onto the big screen in the MPR so that the students can see that you are watching. Zoom participants won't be able to see the audience, but the audience will be able to see you. Hence the etiquette reminder! I will send home more information on this early next week but if you think you will be able at log in, please set aside Monday 13th December from 10:30 am to approximately 11:15am.

In other matters, it is slightly concerning to realise that this is my second last newsletter blurb for the year. FOR THE YEAR! I do not know how that happened so quickly. Our learning programs will begin to wrap up as we move into the last two weeks and we enjoy some time for Christmas craft and group projects. It is a lovely time of year to be able to sit and create with the students and enjoy being creative and reflective for the end of the year. We have certainly had another challenging year and I for one will be very happy when I no longer have to read daily updates about COVID restrictions and guidelines. It would certainly be the best Christmas gift we could all receive to be able to return to some sort of normal. Fingers crossed. It's certainly first on my Christmas list.

COVID Level 3 Guidelines

The school is still operating under level 3 guidelines until at least the end of Term 4. Fully vaccinated volunteers are now allowed back into school as long as they are supporting the curriculum or have a specific role to play. School check-in procedure requires all visitors (including staff and volunteers) to scan the QR code on entry and answer the questions, and also show their vaccination certificate to the Principal or delegate. This is both a legal and Departmental requirement.

Absences

We will continue to send home the Department letter for any unexplained absences each week to help you keep on top of days away. Please remember to send in an absence note via the app or email so we don't need to harass you. We appreciate the text messages to let us know on the day but please follow up with a Skool Loop, email or note.

Great tip - you can list multiple dates and multiple siblings if away at the same time on the app. No need to do a note for each day or each child.

Keeping well

Students must not attend school if unwell. Any person with any symptoms that could be COVID-19 will be sent home, and should not return to school unless they have isolated for 10 days, have a negative test result and are symptom free.


















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End of Year Assembly
