

FIRE PERMITS
NOW DONE
ONLINE

- 1. Plan the burn ahead of time
- 2. Use QR or rfs.nsw.gov.au to apply for a permit to burn.
- 3. Submitted application is received by the volunteer permit officer who may wish to view before approving
- 4. You will be notified and sent a permit via email.
- 5. Go to the website again and and submit a notification to burn. You will have to put in your fire permit (FP) number, (red font top RHS)
- 6. Notify your neighbours 24hrs prior to burning.
